In addition to Public Service Announcements aired in support of National, Regional and Local Organizations and Programs, our programming contains special programs devoted to our community's businesses and organizations. The following lists and describes these special programs.

LOCAL NEWS: Aired twice a day at 7:00 AM and 12:00 PM. News items included relate to local and area events of interest in this community.

EMERGENCY WEATHER ANNOUNCEMENTS: Pending or current emergency weather announcements are given in order to warn or update regional listeners. This includes but is not limited to; road conditions, school and public/county office closings or postponements; energy utility outages; meeting postponements. Often, law enforcement personnel will call in. KVRE is the go to station for current weather conditions.

GOLF REPORT: Aired at 7:31 AM. This gives the local golf course's tee times, conditions, latest noteworthy activities and upcoming special events.

COMMUNITY CALENDAR: This lists local church and organization activities. The need is so great for this type of programming that it airs four times a day; seven days a week.

TAKE FIVE: This special program was created solely to allow a more in-depth interview with key personnel in local business and organizations, thereby allowing the community to have a greater awareness of organizations and new businesses in their area. It features a 5 minute interview daily or sometimes a 15 or 20 minute interview is divided into several segments and aired on successive days. The need for more than one program in a day is often the case.

ASK YOUR NEIGHBOR: An hour open to calls on local and toll-free phone lines, Monday through Friday 10-11am. Hosted by Tom Nichols, only political and medical problems or opinions are not allowed and not for sale for monies notifications. The main purpose of the program is for the listening audience to request information or exchange information on items they need, recipes, help with lawn/household problems; recommendations of local services, etc... Nichols has a loyal and regular listening audience and will occasionally frequent a LIVE interview with a known celebrity or politician.

OTHER SOURCES OF INCOME FOR THE COUNTY IS COURT FINES WHICH HAS BEEN AN ISSUE WITH COURTHOUSE BEING CLOSED FOR 2 MONTHS, SALES TAX IS UP FROM LAST YEAR AND THE STATE TURN BACK IS EXPECTED TO DECREASE BY 5% ON BUDGET. ALL COUNTY OFFICES DID WELL WITH CONSERVATION BUDGETING AND ALL OFFICES ARE DOING OK WITH CURRENT BUDGET.

7/27/20-TAKE 5-TOM NICHOLS INTERVIEWED CHRIS WALTON ATTORNEY FOR SALINE COUNTY. THIS IS PART 2. CHRIS SPOKE ABOUT DEALING WITH THE CORONA VIRUS AND WHY THE OFFICE IS HAVING TO RUN. COVID SHUT DOWN OFFICES BUT THEY CONTINUE TO HAVE HEARINGS BUT NO TRIALS. A NEW PHONE SYSTEM WAS PUT IN TO ASSIST WITH HEARINGS. ALL JURY TRIALS ARE ON HOLD. THEY CONTINUE WITH HEARINGS BY THE NEW PHONE SYSTEM AND PRESSED FORWARD AND ENDED UP PLEADING A CASE AND THE PERSON RECEIVED 25 YEARS IN PRISON BECAUSE HIS OFFICE DID NOT GIVE UP BUT FOUND WAYS TO PRESS FORWARD DURING COVID 19. HE ALSO TALKED ABOUT A CHILD PORN CASE THAT WENT TO TRIAL AND HE RECEIVED 160 YEAR SENTENCE. THEY ALSO HAD NORMAL CASES INVOLVING THEFT AND ELDER ABUSE. THEIR WINNING PERCENTAGE WAS THEY LOST 2 OR 3 CASES OUT OF 20 CASES. THEY FOCUSED ON REPEAT OFFENDERS AND WENT STRONG AFTER THEM.
